STOMACH CONTENTS OF A SPECIMEN OF PROTELES CRISTATUS FROM ANGOLA (CARNIVORA: PROTELIDAE)

On 4 May 1973 an anult male aardwolf *Proteles cristatus* was found dead on the road about 20 km north of Sá da Bandeira, Angola (at about 14° 50′ S/13° 35′ E). The skin and skull were deposited in the Alexander McGregor Memorial Museum, Kimberley, Cape (Collectors No. 276a). The stomach contents of this specimen are detailed in Table 1. The habitat where the specimen was obtained was degraded *Brachystegia* woodland.
