PREFACE

It is a special privilege and rare opportunity to write the preface of a book in honour of a mentor, a quintessential scientist, respectable distinguished Professor, whose illustrious carrier in academics spanned over three decades of scientific research and committed scholarship, with remarkable contributions to the growth and development of education and scientific research in Nigeria and the global community. This accomplished and consummate leader had his academic carrier tightly garnished with key appointments and outstanding performance in strategic administrative units of the University system and further blessed with critical appointments from the Federal Government of Nigeria.

As a Plant Scientist, he immensely appreciates the value of plants in the environment and the intimate relationship between the two. This made him an advocate for the environment and a strong environmental enthusiast. He served the Shell Petroleum Development Company as an environmental adviser and remains a consultant on environmental issues with tremendous works in environmental impact assessment, environmental project and biodiversity studies with publications on global warming, gas flaring, acid rain, erosion, pollution and consequences of deforestation on the environment. His interest in the environment was further buttressed by his active participation in World Environment Day activities, with him being the Conference Convener at IMSU for the World Environment Day celebration of 2018 with the theme "Beat Plastic Pollution" in addition to his impressive lecture on global warming in 2011 Ahiajoku Colloquium.

In view of the above background, I consider it another privilege to be part of the editors of a book of reading titled "Man, Environmental Safety and Sustainability: The Role of Research", which is very apt and a valuable valedictory gift to a committed academic, researcher, and an active member of Nigerian Society for Plant Protection (NSPP) and Mycological Society of Nigeria (MYCOSON), Professor Nathaniel Chukwusimkwuo Ohazurike, who devoted his life to the well-being of plants and the environment.

His friends, colleagues and mentees within and outside the University decided to celebrate and honour him with this book of readings, for his many years of fruitful interactions with us in the field of teaching, research, community service and administrative leadership, as he disengages from formal University employment.

Nathaniel Chukwusimkwuo Ohazurike was born 18th June, 1952 into the catholic family of Chief Fredrick Ajapurumba Onyiriro Ohazurike and Ezinne Alice Iheyinwa Ohazurike of Akpuobu Assah Ubirielem in Orsu LGA of Imo State, Nigeria. He did his primary Education at St. Marys' Primary School,

Assah Ubirielem, and had his Secondary education at Community Grammar School, Awoidemili and completed at Abhot High School, Ihiala, at the end of the civil war.

After his Higher School Certificate Programme at Holy Ghost College Owerri and brief auxillary teaching experience at Uromi Girls Grammar School, Uromi, then Bendel State, he gained admission into the University of Ibadan in 1975 in the Faculty of Science.

Graduating in 1979, he did his NYSC Programme at Government Technical College, Wudil, Kano State. On completion of the NYSC Programme in 1980 and with a good first degree from the University of Ibadan (Second Class Honours upper division), he took up appointment in the Department of Biology at Alvan Ikoku College of Education, Owerri on 1st December, 1980. With perseverance and dedication, Prof Ohazurike earned his higher degrees at the University of Port Harcourt- M.Sc (Mycology and Plant Pathology 1988 and Ph.D (Plant Pathology 1993). After 16 academic sessions (1980/81 to 1995/96) of active teaching (9 years with postgraduate qualification), he joined the services of Imo State University as a senior lecturer in the Faculty of Agriculture on 31st August, 1996. With diligence and commitment, he rose to the rank of Reader in 1999 and Professor of Plant Pathology in 2002.

Since joining the University, every Vice Chancellor has found him very useful in the administrative structure of the system. He was the elected Faculty Representative in the University Senate (1997-2000). He became the pioneer Head of the Department of Crop Science and Biotechnology (2001-2005 and 2006-2007). As a Director of Endowment, he coordinated the activities of the Governing Councils' Committee on endowment from 2000 to 2005 simultaneously with his position as Head of Department and regularly in attendance at council meetings. He became Dean of the Postgraduate School from 2007 to 2009, Dean Faculty of Agriculture (2009-2014), Director of Academic Planning and member of the University Management (2014-2018) and in concert with the University Management and Heads of Departments secured accreditation for 62 out of the 64 academic programmes of the University. He was the chairman, senate business committee throughout the 2011/2012 academic session and has headed several critical senate committees and panels. He also served as Director, Joint Universities Preliminary Examination Board (JUPEB) (2021-2022), from where he retired from formal employment of the University.

From 1989 to date, he has to his credit substantial publications in reputable national and foreign journals, books and conference proceedings and has supervised 15 postgraduate students (MSc and PhD). He has served as an external examiner for 48 postgraduate students (21 PhD and 27 MSc) in 9

Nigerian Universities and has participated in the assessment of 24 academics for promotion to the Professorial Cadre from eleven Nigerian Universities. He was the 26th inaugural lecturer of the Imo State University on 28th November, 2019.

Professor Ohazurike is a member of a good number of professional/learned societies such as Agricultural Society of Nigeria (ASN), Nigerian Society for Plant Protection (NSPP), Botanical Society of Nigeria (BOSON), Mycological Society of Nigeria (MYCOSON) and the American Society for Plant Biologists (ASPB), and a fellow of the Institute of Policy Management Development (IPMD).

From 2006 - 2022, he has served as either member or chairman of several NUC (National University Commission) accreditation teams for accreditation in Universities in virtually all parts of the nation. From 2005 to 2006, he served as Environmental adviser to Shell Petroleum Development Company and has severally served as their consultant on environmental issues. He also served as Chairman, Governing Council of Adeyemi Federal College of Education, Ondo, Ondo State, Nigeria (2017-2020) (Currently, Adeyemi Federal University of Education). He was a member of the Federal Government visitation panel to Federal University Gusau, Zamfara State (2021).

Traditionally, Prof. Ohazurike belongs to all the traditional and chieftaincy institutions of his community and holds chieftaincy titles from several communities including that of his community, Assah Ubirielem viz: "Ugochinemere of Assah Ubirielem" and Ihitte Akata; "Ugonmuta of Awo Idemili" and "Ahakaku of Okwuodor" among others.

He is an active Catholic Christian, a grand Knight/4th degree member of the Knight of St. Mulumba Nigeria and a patron of the Owerri Archdiocesian Mass servers association and patron of Regina Pacis Region Choirs Association (Orlu Diocese). He is also a patron of the Owerri Archdiocesian Catholic Men Organisation. He has served as Chairman, St. Joseph Catholic Chaplaincy Council, IMSU, Owerri (2011 to 2015) with the Church dedicated in his tenure on 25th May 2014. At his home town, he was the chairman, St. Marys' Catholic Parish Council, Assah Ubirielem (2003 to 2010) with the church dedicated to God in his tenure on 25th August 2007. These contributions and several others have earned him several honours and awards too numerous to mention.

Prof. Ohazurike is a dedicated family man. His marriage to his lovely wife Dr. Mrs. Eudora Uche Ohazurike is blessed with a girl and four boys (two engineers, a lawyer and a medical doctor). He is also blessed with five grandchildren and a daughter in-law who is also a lawyer, all to the glory of Almighty God.

This book of readings, consisting of 32 chapters cut across arts and science articles that provide sufficient information to stimulate the interest and curiosity of researchers, lecturers and students, captains of industries, policy makers and implementers, and the general public with rapt interest about our environmental safety.
