Cases Presented

1. Drs. E. C. Botha, N. Jardine and B. M. Kennelly presented the case-history and laboratory data of a patient with postpartum oliguria treated with intravenous mannitol.

This 42-year-old woman was admitted as an emergency case on 4 August with accidental haemorrhage, severe anaemia and hypotension. Transfusion with 4 pints of blood corrected the anaemia and hypotension. Next morning she delivered a macerated foetus. Blood urea was 90 mg./100 ml.

During the 24 hours following admission she received 1,150 ml. of dextrose-water intravenously, plus oral fluids, and her urine output was only 180 ml. Following intravenous mannitol there was a prompt, brisk and sustained diuresis. The blood urea returned to normal after 10 days.

Was the oliguria merely due to dehydration? Or was it due to incipient renal failure owing to early renal shutdown? There was not absolute certainty as the urea and sodium content of the scanty specimens of urine passed before the diuresis were not estimated.

Dr. Kennelly outlined the rationale of the use of intravenous mannitol in the prophylaxis, diagnosis, and management of early renal shutdown, and quoted some personal experience of its use as a diuretic in the management of barbiturate overdosage.

2. Mr. R. Ger presented the diagnostic problem of a 47year-old woman with abdominal cramplike pains, melaena, anaemia, and loss of appetite and weight. A large firm mass filling the left side of her abdomen appeared to arise from the pelvis and to be continuous with the uterus. However, barium enema revealed an unusual-shaped filling defect in the transverse colon.

Possibilities included carcinoma of the colon with coincidental fibroids; ovarian carcinoma invading the colon; com-bined genital and intestinal tuberculosis; and amoeboma colon with coincidental uterine or ovarian disease.
