

2020 Stals Prize winner

The South African Academy for Science and Arts¹ recently awarded the 2020 Stals Prize for Town and Regional Planning to Prof. J.J. (Das) Steyн, Emeritus Professor of the Department of Town and Regional Planning,² University of the Free State. This award is based on, among other things, his numerous publications in Afrikaans and the important role he played in the planning profession in South Africa.



He obtained a B Arch (1972) and the MSS (1978) from the University of the Orange Free State (UOFS), and a M Arch in Urban Design (1979) from Toronto University. He did research for his PhD (1989 UOFS) in The Netherlands under Prof. H.M. Goudapple, and completed his study under the supervision of Professor Wallace van Zyl.

He combined Goudapple's concept of urbanistics with Christian philosophy in an attempt to indicate what happens on various fronts of Town and Regional Planning and how planning theory links practice, theory and the underlying values systems. This runs like a golden thread through his academic work.

As editor of this Journal for the past 21 years, Prof. Das Steyн has focused on planning issues through well-founded headlines. The Journal has grown to such an extent that it is listed on the Norwegian Register for Scientific Journals, as well as the Scientific Electronic Library Online (SciELO) and are read in over 60 countries.

The editorial staff wish to congratulate Prof. Steyн on being awarded this prestigious Stals Prize.

1 The Academy (https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Suid-Afrikaanse_Akademie_vir_Wetenskap_en_Kuns) was founded on 2 July 1909 and has, over the years, regularly granted prestigious prices. Since 1947, nearly 150 Stals prizes have been granted, of which 15 to staff associated with the University of the Free State. This is the first award for the Department of Town and Regional Planning.

2 In 1980, he was appointed lecturer at the University of the Orange Free State. He progressed through the ranks until he retired as departmental chairman in 2009. Thereafter he was a part-time lecturer and since 2015, a research associate at the University of the Free State.

Die Suid-Afrikaanse Akademie vir Wetenskap en Kuns¹ het die 2020-Stalsprys vir Stads- en Streeksbeplanning aan prof. J.J. (Das) Steyн, emeritus professor van die Departement Stads- en Streeksbeplanning,² Universiteit van die Vrystaat, toegeken. Dit is gegrond op, onder andere, sy talle publikasies in Afrikaans en die belangrike rol wat hy in die beplanningsprofession in Suid-Afrika gespeel het.

Hy verwerf B Arch (1972) en die MSS (1978) aan die Universiteit van die Oranje Vrystaat en 'n M Arch (1979) in Stedelike Ontwerp) aan Toronto Universiteit. Vir sy PhD (1989 UOVS) doen hy navorsing in Nederland onder professor H.M. Goudappel, en voltooi sy studie onder leiding van professor Wallace van Zyl.

Deur Goudappel se urbanistiek konsep te kombineer met die Christelike wysbegeerte poog hy om te verklaar wat op verskillende fronte van die Stads- en Streeksbeplanning gebeur en hoe die praktyk, teoretiese denke en die onderliggende waardesisteme met mekaar skakel in die beplanningsteorie. Hierdie loop soos 'n goue draad deur sy akademiese werk.

Vir die afgelope 21 jaar was Das Steyн redakteur van hierdie tydskrif, waarin hy deur gefundeerde hoofberigte beplanningskwesties onder die soeklig plaas. Die tydskrif is uitgebou tot 'n tydskrif wat op die lys van die Noorweegse Register vir Wetenskaplike Tydskrifte, asook die Scientific Electronic Library Online (SciELO) verskyn en in meer as 60 lande gelees word.
